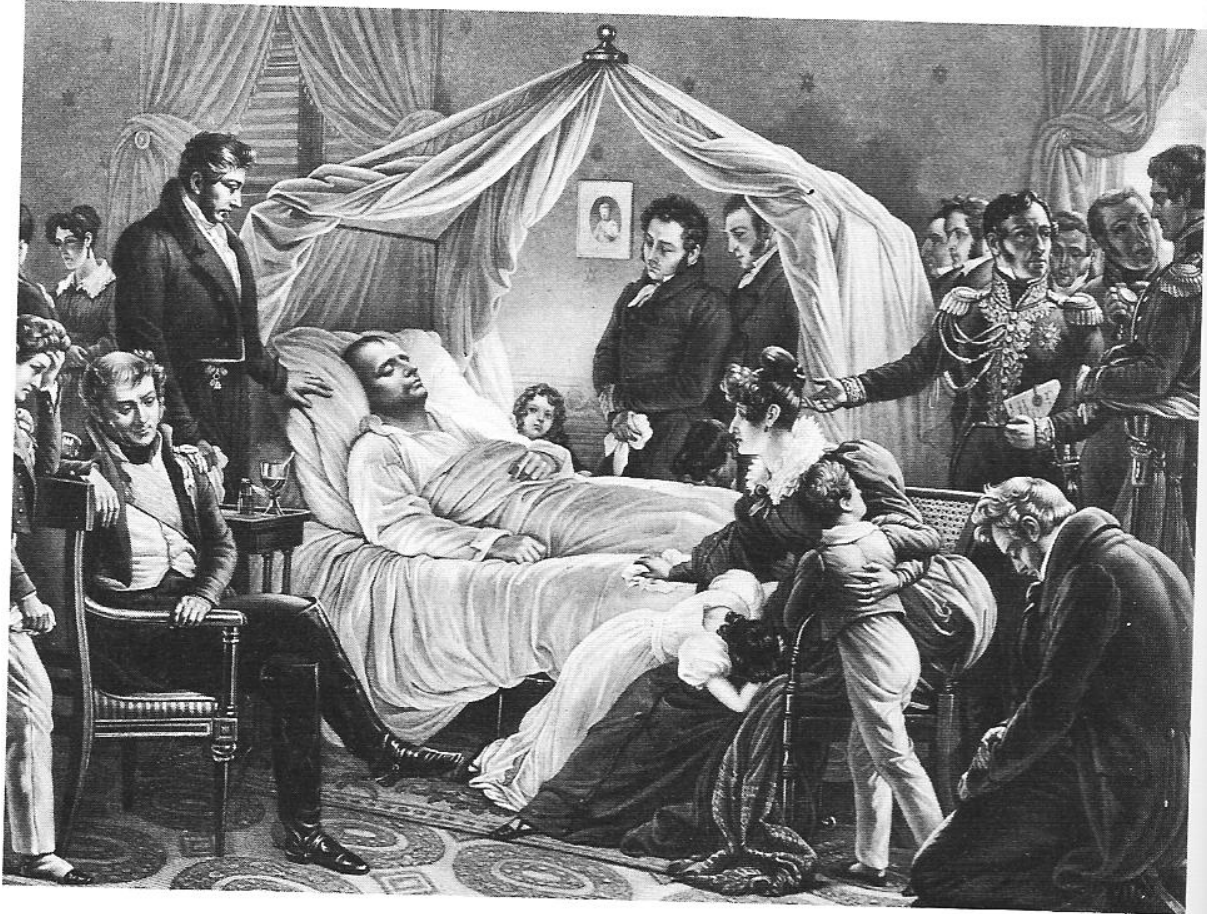


Napoléon I Bonaparte's death

11. Fanny Bertrand sits on a chair.
12. Henry Bertrand leans towards Fanny Bertrand.
13. Jean Baptiste Pierron has a particularly large and curved nose.
14. Achille Thomas Archambault stands to the left of Jean Baptiste Pierron.
15. Charles Tristan de Montholon holds a document.
16. Jean Abram Noverraz sits on his knees with his eyes closed.
17. Jacques Coursot stands behind Charles Tristan de Montholon.
18. Archibald Arnott opens his mouth as if to say something.
19. William Crokat holds a watch.
